Outline Description	Church of St Anthony
Property Description	Church of St Anthony and St Catherine rebuilt in 1828 over a previous church that was first built in 1571. The titular painting of the Church shows a Madonna with Child, flanked by St Anthony of Padua and St Catherine. It has an elliptical structure and is surmounted by a dome and a lantern. The facade has two composite columns on each side of a main door with an angular pediment surmounted by an elliptical oculus window. There is a belfry at the back.
